
A date for the plaque dedication is to be confirmed, it looks like March 2008.

In early July a number of Ex Survey Corps members paid a visit to the Survey Museum at The Royal Australian Engineers at Holsworthy to catalogue equipment and material held at the museum. It is proposed that a regular working bee be formed to assist in presenting the material held at the museum so it can be displayed. The allocated space is about a quarter of the building comprising the Engineer Museum.

Leaving Canberra on Monday night after the unveiling of the plague the group of members who had volunteered spent two full days sorting, identifying and listing the material

The range of items is huge, from a single colour offset printing press, the Johnson Ground Elevation Meter (which attracted a lot of interest) Doppler satellite equipment, B8 plotters, Curta calculators, slide rules, plane tables, clinometers, alidades, plaques, trophies and Ken Slaters football boots as a memento of the 'Fortuna Falcons'. There are containers of reports and documents which should be digitized into a data base. What to do with it all? There is so much more to do!

A general layout plan has been devised - possibly following the mapping process from field to printed map with equipments used through the years.

Like all museums, it may be possible to display only the 'tip of the iceberg'. Another working bee is intended for late September. Date to be advised.
